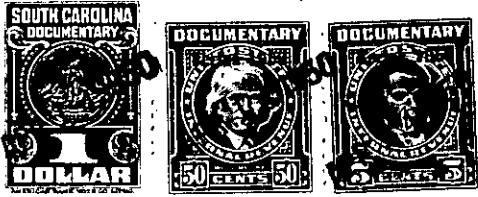

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John A. Gilbert and Frances P. Gilbert.....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,

County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot #4 of Property of J. W. Hudgens and L. P. Langston, according to a Plat made by M. H. Woodward, R. E., in July, 1946, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "B" at Page 47, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING AT AN IRON PIN ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF OAK STREET AT THE JOINT FRONT CORNER OF LOTS #4 and #5, and running thence S. 41-45 E. 181.5 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots #4 and #5; thence S. 48-15 W. 79.0 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 41-45 W. 181.5 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots #3 and #4; thence along Oak Street N. 48-15 E. 79.0 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

The grantees are to pay the 1950 taxes on the above property.
