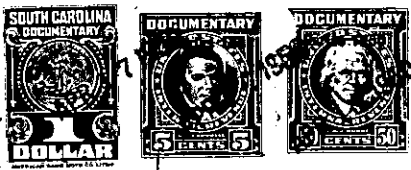
Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ernest Wynn and Grace Wynn

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles northeast of Taylors, S. C., and lying on the south side of a County surface treated road, known and designated as Lots 1 and 2 as shown on plat of R. L. Wynn Estate, plat made by J. Q. Bruce March 18, 1950, said plat to be recorded in RMC office for said County, and described as follows: BEGINNING On a stake at intersection of said surface treated road and another road, and running thence with the northern edge of said other road S. 51-20 E. 236 feet to a stake; thence N. 41-08 E. 113 feet to a stake, joint corner of lots 2 and 3; thence N. 8-45 W. 186 feet to a point or stake on the southern edge of said surface treated road; joint corner of lots 2 and 3; thence with the southern edge of said surface treated road S. 61-51 W. 261 feet to the point of beginning, and being a part of that certain tract conveyed to R.
