All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, near Woodside Cotton Mills, being known and designated as Lot "B" according to a plat of Woodside Mills, Greenville, South Carolina, prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, March 7, 1950, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of East South Sixth Street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. "A" and "B", which point is 75 feet West of the North-western intersection of Vance Street and East South Sixth Street, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 15-49 E. 100 feet to a point; thence N. 74-11 W. 75 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots "B" and "C"; thence with the joint line of said lots S. 15-49 W. 100 feet to a point in the Northern side of East South Sixth Street; thence with the Northern side of said street 75 feet to the beginning corner.
