all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the east side of Wilkins Alley, more particularly described as follows;

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Wilkins Alley at corner of lot #2, shown on plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat Book L, page 75; and running thence along East side of Wilkins Alley in a north westerly direction 36 feet 2 inches, more or less, to iron pin; thence S.81-29 E. 66 feet to iron pin; thence in a southerly direction forty one feet, seven inches (41.ft.7 In"), more or less, to iron pin on northern line of lot #2 shown on said plat; which iron pin measures 63 ft, 9 inches, more or less from the east side of Wilkins Alley; thence along said line of lot #2, N.76-15 W, 63 ft, 9 inches to the point of beginning.

This being a portion of lot # 1 shown on said plat, and is a portion of the property conveyed to Adny W. Seaborn by the Workingman's Savings & Loan Company by deed dated May 23, 1903, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book JJJ page 593.
