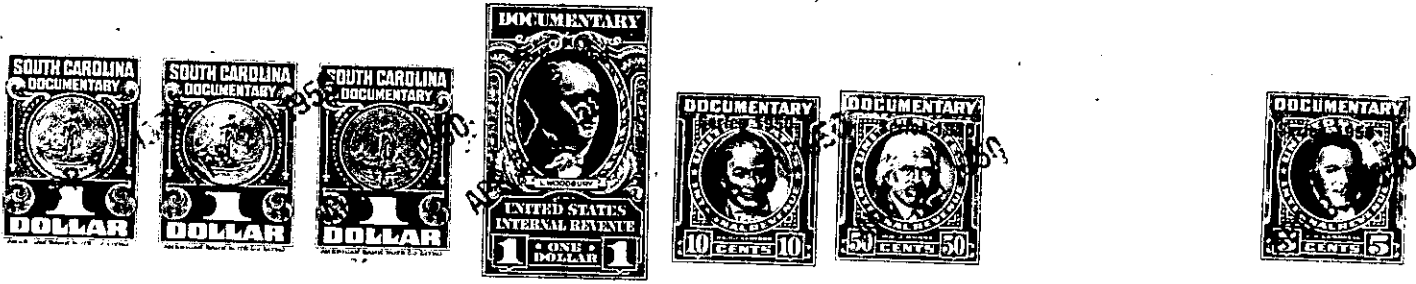

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. G. Sirrine

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred and no/100----- Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by George W. Hill,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George W. Hill,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a part of the old Shockley Home Place, located on the Hunt's Bridge Road, approximately eight miles from Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat of J. C. Hill dated August, 1948:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of public road at corner of property now or formerly of W. W. Gibson, and running thence along center of public road, S. 85 E. 231 feet to iron pin; thence continuing along said road N. 50 E. 254 feet to iron pin; thence S 9-20 E. 778 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 54-15 W. 589 feet to point in center of spring; thence S. 8 E. 745 feet to a stake; thence N. 41-45 W. 938 feet to W. O., thence N. 28-30 E. 726 feet to White Oak Stump; thence N. 17-30 E. 467.94 feet to iron pin at the point of beginning.
