to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AUGUST W. KREMPIN, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northern side of Prancer Avenue within the new city limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot # 280, according to plat of Pleasant Valley prepared by Dalton & Neves, April 1946, as revised through February, 1950, and as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", at Page 92, and according to further plat of Lot #280 recorded in said Office in Plat Book "T", at Page 224, and having, according to said plats, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Prancer Avenue in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Prancer Avenue with Panama Avenue; thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet along Panama Avenue to an iron pin at the common corner of Lots # 280 and # 223 on the Western side of Panama Avenue; thence S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots # 280 and # 281; thence S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots # 280 and # 281, on the Northern side of Prancer Avenue; thence along said Avenue N. 89-52 E. 60 feet to an iron pin in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Prancer Avenue with Panama Avenue, the point of beginning.
