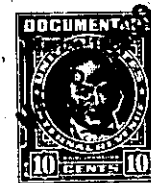

County, State of South Carolina, on the East side of Waccamaw Avenue, near the
City of Greenville, and according to a survey made by Dalton & Neves, July 29, 1946,

BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Waccamaw Avenue, 1287.3 feet
South from Augusta Drive, and running thence S. 78-02 E. 225 feet to a stake at
corner of property of Wayman W. Henry and Helen B. Henry; thence with line of said
property, S. 11-58 W. 70 feet to a stake at corner of said property; thence
continuing with line of said property, N. 78-02 W. 225 feet to a stake on Waccamaw
Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Waccamaw Avenue, N. 11-58 E. 70 feet to
