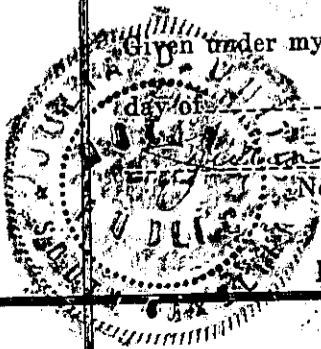
Renunciation of Dower
