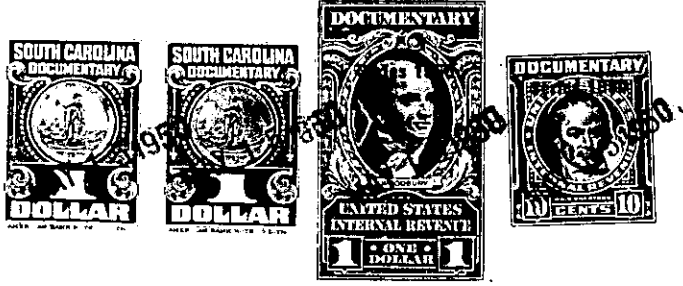

by Malcom L. Kelley  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Malcom L. Kelley, his Heirs  
and Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, located in the new corporate limits of the  
City of Greer, lying on the south side of King Street, being shown  
and designated as lot No. 131 on Plat of Property of W. H. Brockman  
Estate made by Dalton & Neves, Eng's June 1926, said plat being re-  
corded in the R. M. C. for said county in Plat Book "H" at page 132  
and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin on the south side of King Street, joint  
corner of lots 130 and 131, and runs thence with the common line of  
lots 130 and 131, S. 12-00 W. 193 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of  
lots 130, 131, 134 and 135; thence with the common line of lots 131 and  
134, S. 75-33 E. 70.06 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 131,  
and 132 and on the line of lot 134; thence with the common line of  
lots 131 and 132, N. 12-00 E. 196 feet to an iron pin on the south  
side of King Street; thence with the south side of King Street,  
N. 78-00 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner. G11-5-2
