

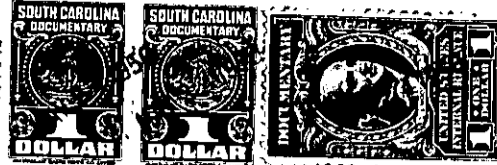

That We, R. K. Taylor and R. K. Taylor, Jr. in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS AND OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATION

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T. D. CHRISTOPHER and FRANCES B. CHRISTOPHER, their heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Broad Vista Boulevard, in a subdivision known as Super Highway Home Sites, being known and designated as Lot No. 155 of said subdivision, and being as shown on a plat of said subdivision prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated May, 1946, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book P at page 53, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Broad Vista Boulevard at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 154 and 155, and running thence along the common line of said lots N. 88-07 W. 175.6 feet to an iron pin in the center of a five-foot strip reserved for utilities; thence along the center of said five-foot strip N. 6-40 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 155 and 156; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 155 and 156 N. 84-47 E. 162.7 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Broad Vista Boulevard; thence along the Western side of Broad Vista Boulevard S. 4-12 E. 80 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The above described property is conveyed subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Super Highway Home Sites, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 291 at page 369. Said property is also conveyed subject to such easements and rights of way as may appear of record.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

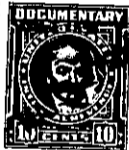
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, his Heirs and Assigns forever.
