

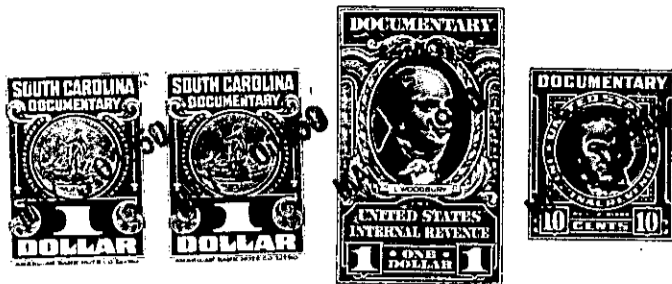

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Harlon Riggins,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the south side
of East North Street Extension, (which was formerly known as
"Old Spartanburg Road"), being the same conveyed to grantor
herein by J. W. Norwood on the 12th day of September, 1938,
deed recorded in the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville
County, S. C. in Book 205, page 354. In the deed of J. W.
Norwood the lot is described as follows:

In Greenville Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, On the South side of the Old Spartanburg
Road, being known and designated as part of lot No. 51
according to plat of H. O. Jones, Engineer, made September
17, 1913, recorded in Plat Book "E" at page 252, and having
the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point on the South side of the Old
Spartanburg Road, joint Northern corner of Lots No. 50
and 51, and running thence along the dividing line of
said lots S. 8-30 E. 200 feet to a point on a new back
line; thence N. 76-07 E. 60 feet to a point; thence N.
7-41 W. 200 feet to a point on the South side of North
Street Extension; thence along said North Street Ex-
tension S. 76-07 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
