

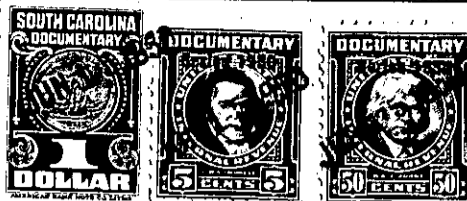

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 108 of Newtown.

According to Plat property of P. R. Long and Walter Goldsmith made by Dalton and Neves, said plat being recorded in RMC office, Greenville County, in Book C-Page 21, May 1944 and being more particularly described as following:

Beginning at an iron pin on South side of Walnut Street at intersection of 16 ft.
