to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T.G. HAWKINS, His Heirs & Assigns Forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, containing 17.4 acres, more or less, in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of the White Horse Road, and having according to a survey and plat by W.A. Hester, dated August 11, 1924, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the White Horse Road, at corner of property now or formerly of Wm. Martin; thence along the center of said White Horse Road, N. 18-00 E. 10.00 chains to point; thence along property now or formerly of Dr. Garlington, N. 84-24 W. 17.80 chains to a stone; thence along line of property now or formerly of Thomas Ward, S. 22-30 W. 5.80 chains to a stone; thence continuing along Ward's land, S. 4-20 W. 3.90 chains to a stone; thence along line of property now or formerly of Wm. Martin, S. 84-24 W. 17.40 chains to point of beginning.

The above tract is part of an original tract of 34 acres, more or less, owned jointly by the Grantor and Grantee and by them mutually partitioned by two separate deeds Dated February 9, 1925, recorded in Deed Book 96, page 378 and Deed Book 96, page 379. This deed is made in order to correct that error and the parties are this day making mutual deeds each conveying to the other the original tract and acreage so intended in the original partition of 1925.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and HIS Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
