THIS CONVEYANCE, TRANSFER AND ASSIGNMENT, Made this the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1950, by GREENVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC LIGHT & POWER COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Greenville Company", to DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New Jersey, hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Power Company",

W I T N E S S E T H: THAT,

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described property was owned by and in the possession of the Greenville Company on and before the 25th day of June, 1913, and it was the intention of said Greenville Company and of Southern Public Utilities Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maine, that all of said property be transferred, assigned, granted and conveyed by the Greenville Company to said Southern Public Utilities Company, and with that intention and for that purpose deed was executed by the Greenville Company to said Southern Public Utilities Company under date of June 25, 1913, which deed was duly recorded in the public registry of Greenville County in Book 22 at page 313; and,

WHEREAS, said Southern Public Utilities Company, by deed dated April 4, 1935, duly recorded in the public registry of Greenville County in Book 179 at page 166, assigned, transferred, granted and conveyed said property to Southern Public Utilities Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New Jersey; and,

WHEREAS, by deed of said Southern Public Utilities Company, organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey, to Duke Power Company dated May 1, 1935, duly recorded in the public registry of Greenville County in Book 183 at page 253, and by merger of said Southern Public Utilities Company into Duke Power Company, title to and right of possession of said property became vested in Duke Power Company; and,
