C.; its successors or assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of Meridian Avenue, in a subdivision known as Super Highway Home Sites, being known and designated as Lot No. 69 of said subdivision, and being described according to a plat of Super Highway Home Sites, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated May, 1946, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "P" at Page 53, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Meridian Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 69 and 70, and running thence along the common line of said lots S. 88-0 E. 182.5 feet to an iron pin in the center of a five-foot strip reserved for utilities; thence along the center of said five-foot strip S. 2-00 W. 80 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 68 and 69; thence along the common line of said lots N. 88-0 W. 182.5 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Meridian Avenue; thence along the Eastern side of Meridian Avenue N. 2-00 E. 80 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The above described property is conveyed subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Super Highway Home Sites, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 291 at Page 369. Said property is also conveyed subject to such easements and rights-of-way as may appear of record.

Grantee agrees to pay taxes for the year 1950.

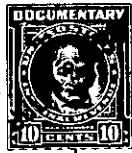
