THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 1st day of February, A.D., 1950, by and between J. V. Robinson, doing business as Mutual Petroleum Company, hereinafter referred to as the First Party, and Paul K. Thackston, hereinafter referred to as the Second Party,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Second Party is the owner of a certain tract of land located on the Fork Shoals Road on which he owns, maintains and operates a general mercantile store with a filling station in front, and,

WHEREAS, the First Party is the owner and operator of a wholesale petroleum products business located in Greenville, South Carolina, and,

WHEREAS, the Second Party is operating a retail service station upon the above described premises and is desirous of handling petroleum products sold by the First Party, and,

WHEREAS, the First Party is willing to furnish said petroleum products to the Second Party upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Fifteen and 81/100 (\$515.81) Dollars paid with the signing of these presents by the First Party to the Second Party, (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) and the further promises and conditions on the part of the First Party as hereinafter set forth, the said parties hereto agree as follows:

I.

The Second Party agrees to purchase all gasoline, kerosene and other petroleum products sold on the above described premises from the First Party at the prevailing market price at the time of each sale, during the term of this agreement.
