

SECTION 6. That the said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc., its successors and assigns, in the conduct of such telephone service shall have the right forthwith to deny service to any patron who fails to pay the reasonable and usual rental required and to observe the rules and regulations adopted for the conduct of the service.

SECTION 7. The Town of Simpsonville agrees to pay the established rates for telephone service for the duration of this agreement and the Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc. agrees to furnish telephone service at any place or places as designated by the Mayor of the Town of Simpsonville for the official use and transaction of official business for the Town of Simpsonville, said service to be limited to the Incorporate limits of the Town of Simpsonville, S. C. This provision shall not apply to the property tax imposed, levied, or assessed upon the property of the said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc., nor or hereafter situate in the said Town of Simpsonville, but shall apply to all other taxes which might be imposed upon the said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc., for doing business within the said Town or for the privileges and franchises granted under this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. That the said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc. shall be held responsible for any and all damages caused by negligence on the part of the said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc.

SECTION 9. That the said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc. shall have the right to make its own rules and regulations not inconsistent with the laws of this State for the use and rental of its telephones, and for connections with other lines of telephone leading from the said town of Simpsonville, and may make such charges therefor as are not inconsistent with the laws of this State.
