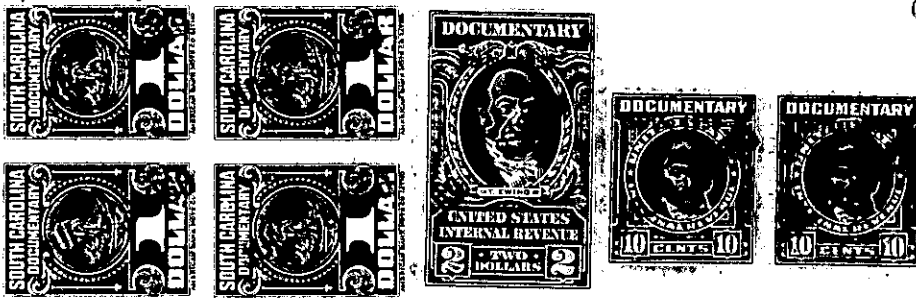

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southeast side of Hampton Street, 390 feet Southeast from Crane Avenue, and running thence S. 23-50 E. 200 feet to stake; thence S. 47-05 W. 60 feet to iron pin at the rear corner of lot No. 27; thence with the rear line of lots 26 and 27, as shown on plat of City View Annex, N. 23-50 W. 200 feet to a pin on Hampton Street; thence with Hampton Street, N. 47-05 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
