

Louis Coward Construction Co., Inc. and M. G. Proffitt, plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1950, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Brookside Way, at a point where said street is intersected by the southern side of a ten foot reservation for pipes and poles and running thence along said ten foot reservation for pipes and poles, N. 54-40 W. 239.5 feet to an iron pin at the corner of property now or formerly of Coy L. Huffman, Jr.; thence along the line of the property now or formerly of Coy L. Huffman, Jr., S. 30-24 W. 246.2 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Brook-side Way; thence along the northern side of Brookside Way in a curved line the following courses and distances, to-wit: N. 88-32 E. 41 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 82-44 E. 70.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-48 E. 81.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-28 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 67-45 E. 67.9 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
