CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

did on the 8th day of August, 1950, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **PIEDMONT BROADCASTING COMPANY, INC.**
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is **GREENVILLE, S. C.**
- FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

to obtain radio broadcasting construction permits and licenses from public authorities; to establish, purchase, own, lease, operate and maintain radio broadcasting stations for the purpose of sending and/or receiving all forms of radio communications utilizing sound and/or vision, as at present or hereinafter developed or invented, whether by electrical impulses or otherwise and irrespective of the instrumentalities or methods employed; to deal generally in the business of radio advertising and all activities incidental thereto; to engage in the business of originating, producing, reproducing, exploiting, performing, and disseminating news, music, advertising, and all forms of entertainment; and in general to engage in all activities necessary, appropriate or incidental to the conduct of radio broadcasting stations.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00)** - - - - - Dollars payable in property and services.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **One Hundred (100)** of the par value of **One Hundred (\$100.00)** - - - - - Dollars.

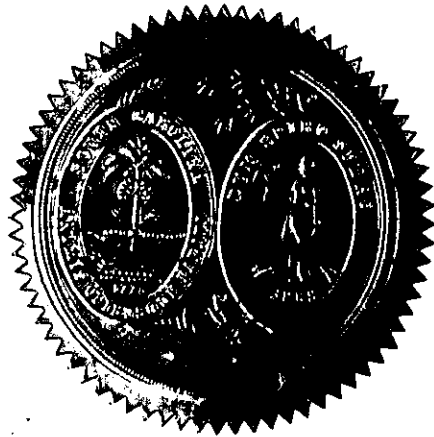
SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **7th** day of **August**, 19 **50**, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:
Vardry D. Ramseur, J. A. Ramseur, Joe H. Britt and Chas. B. Britt

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **Vardry D. Ramseur** ; as Vice-President, **Chas. B. Britt** ; as Secretary, **J. A. Ramseur** ; as Treasurer, **J. A. Ramseur**

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **The Greenville Piedmont** a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this **8th** day of **August** in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and **fifty** and in the one hundred and **seventy-fifth** year of the Independence of the United States of America.
