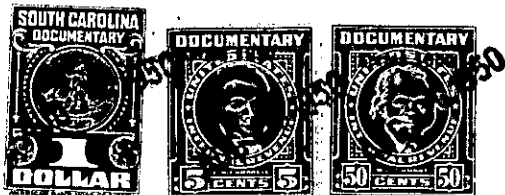

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Miss Eva Turner

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, Located about Two miles south of Gowensville  
in Greenville county, on the north side of tar road, known as the  
Turner road. Beginning at a stake on south edge of said road, and  
runs thence with the P. Turner estate line N. 20.26 E. 301 feet to  
a stake in said Turner line; thence S. 3.04 E. 204.3 feet to a point  
in center of said Turner road, marked by a Cocola bottle cap.  
thence S. 55.00 W. 140 feet with road to the beginning corner  
and contains 28/100 of an acre more or less as per survey of  
J.H. Atkins, surveyor, 7th day of August, 1950
