

but shall be removed or burned on the premises. It is also understood that the grantees will pay any damage which may hereafter result to any crops growing along the right of way and will always enter upon the right of way for repairs in a manner which will do no more damage than absolutely necessary to any growing crops or pasture land within the right of way.

The right of way and easements hereby granted shall be binding upon and shall enure to the parties hereto, their successors, heirs and assigns.
