in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Marie B. Lineberger, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Paris Mountain Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of a subdivision known as Paris Mountain Farms as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book N, at page 13, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of the Paris Mountain road at the corner of Lot No. 8, and running thence along the line of that lot, N. 41-30 W. 250 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 14 in line of said Lot No. 8; thence along the line of said Lot No. 14, N. 48-30 E. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 10, in line of Lot No. 14; thence along the line of said Lot No. 10, S. 41-30 E. 250 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the northwest side of Paris Mountain Road; thence along the line of said Paris Mountain Road, S. 48-30 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is the same Lot No. 9 included in the deed of E. O. Thompson to the grantors by deed dated August 30, 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 390 at page 219.

The grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1950, said taxes having been prorated as of this date.
