Stoneman, her heirs and assigns forever, an undivided one-half interest in and to:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the East side of Longview Terrace, and being known and designated as Lot No. 41, as shown on a Plat of Forest Heights, prepared by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, recorded in Plat Book P at Page 71, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
