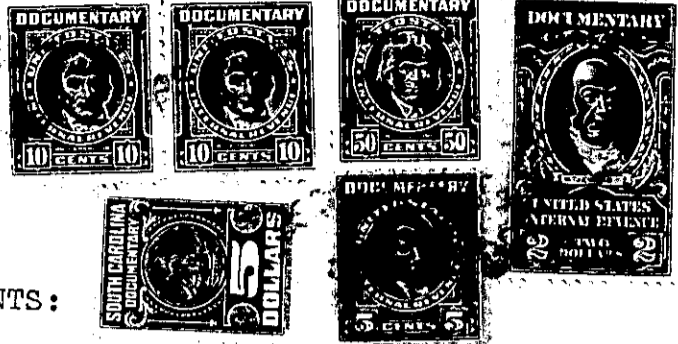

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, James N. Campbell, Iler C. Griffin, Lowell W. Campbell, Charlton N. Campbell, Fred L. Campbell, Lowell Campbell, Guy Campbell, Lillian C. Green, Grace C. Timms, Louise C. Bagwell, Magdalene C. Coster, Hattie Lee C. Jordan, Hazel H. Moore, Angline Sines, Evelyn H. Aiken, Ruth H. Ashmore and Bonnie H. Simmons, the heirs at law of J. L. Campbell, who died on the 17th day of April, 1949, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars to the Grantors, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the Grantee (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary Hester Johnson, her heirs and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 10 of City View as shown on plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "A" at pages 460 and 461, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on YMCA Street 100 feet from the Southwest corner of Summitt Street and YMCA Street and running thence along the line of Lot No. 9, N. $89\frac{1}{2}$ W. 150 feet to a ten foot alley; thence along said alley, S. 0-30 W. 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 11; thence with line of Lot No. 11, S. $89\frac{1}{2}$ E. 150 feet to an iron pin on YMCA Street; thence N. 0-30 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner and being the same property conveyed to J. L. Campbell, dec'd. by deed of M. D. Garrett dated July 10, 1929 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 148 at page 371.
