TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, A. ROY ASHLEY, United States Marshal for the Western District of South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the United States of America on or about the 26th day of April, 1950, filed its Complaint (Civil Action No. 1056) in the United States District Court for the Western District of South Carolina in the Greenville Division of said District against O. O. Perry, W. J. Perry, Jr., et al., demanding judgment in relation to the premises hereinafter mentioned and described, and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 23rd day of August, 1950, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in an order of said Court whereby it was adjudged and decreed that said premises hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by the United States Marshal for the Western District of South Carolina on the terms and for the purpose mentioned in said Order; and the said United States Marshal after having duly advertised the said premises for sale by public outcry on the 2nd day of October, 1950, did then, openly and publicly, and according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of same unto the United States of America for the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred and no/100 (\$4,300.00) Dollars, it being at that price the highest bidder therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, A. Roy Ashley, as United States Marshal for the Western District of South Carolina, in consideration of the premises have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the United States of America and its assigns:
