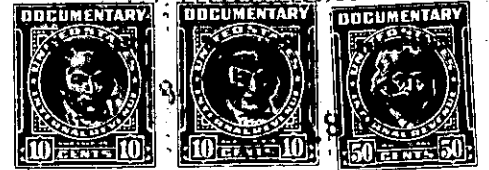

Know all Men by these presents, That

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Sixty-Nine Hundred, Fifty and No/100 - - - - - (\$6950.00) - - - - - Dollars

to me paid by Nora Lee Canady

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and re-
leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Nora Lee Canady, her
heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the
State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, near Judson Mills
just off the Easley Bridge Road, known as Lot No. 8 on plat of Block N, Highland sub-
division, recorded in Plat Book E, at page 208, and being more particularly describ-
ed as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Florida avenue, corner of
Lot No. 6 (280 feet South of the Easley Bridge Road), and running thence with the line
of that lot, (No. 6) N. 71 E. 168.87 feet to the corner of Lot No. 9; thence with the
line of that lot in a Southerly direction 80 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 10;
thence with the line of that lot, S. 71 W. 159.98 feet to an iron pin on Florida avenue;
thence with said avenue, N. 22-10 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.

This lot is shown on the Township Block Book at Sheet 228, Block 5, Lot 14,
and the grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1950, said taxes having been pro-rated
as of this date.

The above described lot is the same conveyed to grantor by C. T. Scott by
deed dated February 11, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Deed Vol. 286, at page 422.
