

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

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THAT I, JAMES DODD HENSON, a Sgt. 1cl ER 20 441 214 in the United States Army, desiring to empower my attorney-in-fact as herein after appointed to transact any and all of my business and personal affairs for me at all times and under all conditions to the same extent and with the same authority as I myself could do, do hereby constitute, name and appoint my wife, Catherine May Henson, my attorney-in-fact for me and in my name, place and stead to transact any and all business concerning any and all property, real, personal or mixed, which I may own separately, jointly or in community, or in which I do now or may hereafter have any interest whatsoever.

Without excluding any other powers conferred herein, and not in limitation thereof, I do especially authorize my said attorney-in-fact to sell, convey, release, mortgage or otherwise alienate or encumber any and all such property, real, personal or mixed, or any interest therein, including real estate, personal effects, automobiles, securities, bank accounts and other choses in action which I may own jointly, separately or in community or in which I may have any interest whatsoever now or in the future, and to execute in my name and deliver all written instruments necessary for the accomplishment of any or all of the above enumerated powers; to commence and carry on, or to defend, all actions and proceedings touching my property, real, personal or mixed, or any part thereof; also to demand, sue for, enforce payment of, receive and give discharges for all moneys, securities for moneys, debts, chattels or other personal or real estate now or hereafter belonging to me.

My said attorney-in-fact is further authorized to make purchases at mercantile establishments and to charge the same to me, thereby making me financially responsible for the same. My said attorney-in-fact is authorized to endorse for me and in my name any and all checks from whatever source, representing amounts of money due me for any reason whatsoever; to withdraw funds from my bank accounts at any and all banks at which I may now or hereafter have accounts, and to sign checks and drafts against such accounts and to transact any and all business pertinent thereto; to execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipment of household effects as authorized by law and Army regulations, and to receive, endorse, and collect the proceeds of checks payable to my order drawn on the Treasurer of the United States.

The purpose and intent of this power of attorney is to clothe my said attorney-in-fact with all power and authority over my property, business and personal affairs including any and all joint, separate or community property in which I may now or hereafter have any interest whatsoever, to the same extent and with the same power and authority which I myself might exercise, and such power and authority as hereby expressly so conferred; hereby ratifying and confirming each and everything my said attorney-in-fact shall do or purport to do by virtue of these presents.
