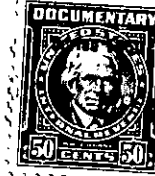

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lafayette Dill

All that piece, parcel or tract of  
land, situated, lying and being  
in the State and County aforesaid  
said in Glassy Mountain Town-  
ship on the north side of  
Middle Tiger River, having the  
following metes and bounds:  
to wit: Beginning at a  
stake in the center of said  
river; thence N 5 E 27.50 ch. to a  
stone in a path; thence N 8 3 1/2 S 80  
8.75 ch. to a stone in forks of  
branch; thence down and with  
the meanderings of said branch  
to middle Tiger River; thence  
down and with meanderings of  
said river to the beginning  
corner; containing Twenty four  
(24) acres more or less  
forming lands of John Drain,  
J. N. Brown and others.  
This being the same land deeded  
to me by J. H. Howard, January
