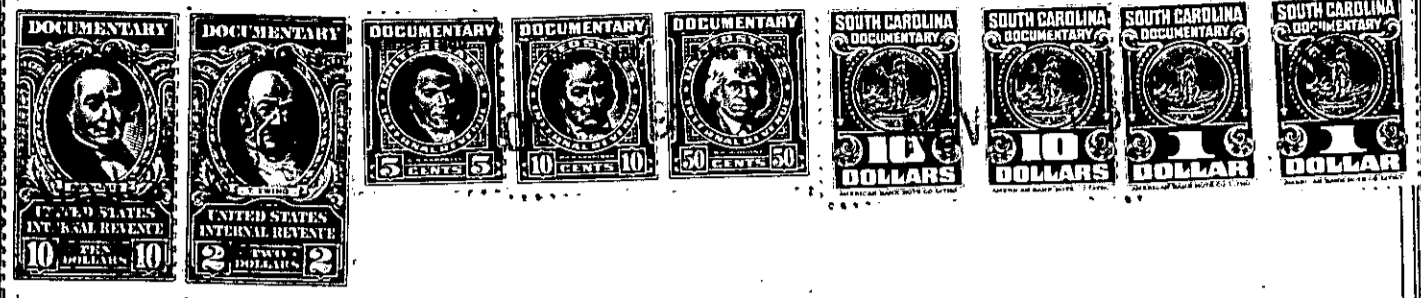

to ~~me~~ in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by **Eliza D. Carlisle**
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **Eliza D. Carlisle, her heirs and assigns**
forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Greenville** Township, **Greenville**
County, State of South Carolina, and on the east side of Watson Street in the
City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 12 on
plat of the property of Grace W. Griffith and Charles P. Watson, as
shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book "G", page 164, and having the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Watson Street at
the joint corner of Lots 11 and 12, which point is 153 feet from the
Southeast intersection of Watson Street and Grace Street, and running
thence with the joint line of said Lots 11 and 12, N. 71-00 E. 116.4
feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 17-55 E. 51 feet to an
iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13; thence with the
joint line of said lots, S. 70-58 W. 115.6 feet to an iron pin on
Watson Street; thence with said **Watson Street**, N. 18-40 W. 51 feet to
the beginning corner.
