BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Patrol Road, which
point is 652 feet in an Easternly direction from the intersection of
the New Buncombe Road with the Patrol Road and which point is in the
center of said forty-two foot strip and running thence S. 27-45 E.
274 feet; thence N. 85-0 E. 597 feet still down the center of said
forty-two foot strip; thence still down the center of said forty-
two foot strip, N. 50-0 E. 460 feet to a point on the West side of
