do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said...The Housing Authority of the City of  
Greenville, South Carolina, its successors and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being on both sides of a County Road known as the Greenacre Road and on the West and Southwest side of the McAlister Road, and having according to a plat entitled "Norris Property" prepared by The McPherson Company, Engineers, August 30, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the intersection of the McAlister Road and a County Road known as the Greenacre Road leading to Greenacre, at the corner of other property of the Grantor and running thence along the said Greenacre Road S. 46-49 W. 133.58 feet to a concrete monument on the Western edge of said Greenacre Road; thence N. 31-06 W. 114.75 feet to a poplar tree; thence N. 44-25 W. 1026.83 feet to a concrete monument on the Western edge of a private road known as the Webster Road; thence along the Western and North-western edge of said private road the following courses and distances: N. 72-26 E. 105.32 feet to a concrete monument; thence N. 62-22 E. 57.66 feet to a concrete monument; thence N. 53-36 E. 142.41 feet to a concrete monument; thence N. 45-36 E. 75.05 feet to a concrete monument; thence along a curved course the chord of which is N. 37-49 E. 167.70 feet to a concrete monument; thence N. 14-48 E. 98.13 feet to a concrete monument; thence N. 24-39.5 E. 161.43 feet to a concrete monument; thence leaving the said private road and along property now or formerly of R. P. Webster N. 26-00.5 W. 228.23 feet crossing a branch to a concrete monument; thence S. 49-33 W. crossing two branches 577.12 feet to a concrete monument; thence S. 43-08 W. 1018.07 feet crossing two branches to a concrete monument; thence S. 43-49 W. 510.45 feet to a concrete monument; thence S. 0-30 W. 413.29 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 30-31 E. 213.38 feet and crossing a creek to a poplar tree near the East bank of said creek; thence S. 78-51 E. 171.13 feet to a concrete monument; thence S. 87-48 E. 2045.59 feet crossing the Greenacre Road to a point in the middle of the McAlister Road; thence N. 27-30 E. 236.35 feet to a concrete monument near the Eastern edge of said Road; thence N. 45-28.5 W. 667.95 feet to point of beginning.
