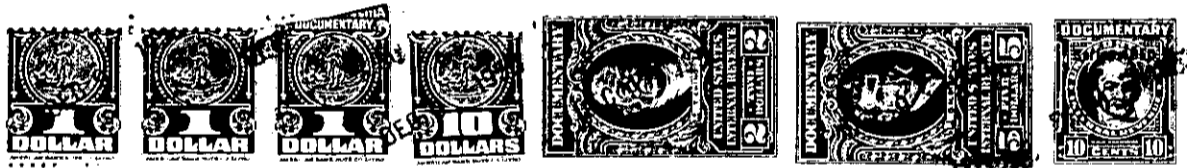
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Harold James Burton, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Southern side of Pacific Avenue within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 358 according to plat of Pleasant Valley prepared by Dalton & Neves, April 1946, including additions to said plat through September 1950, as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book P, page 94, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Pacific Avenue at joint front corner of Lots Nos 357 and 358; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 0-08 E. 224.8 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 357 and 358; thence N. 62-34 E. 67.65 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 358 and 359; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 0-08 W. 193.8 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Pacific Avenue at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 358 and 359; thence along said Avenue S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 357 and 358, the point of beginning.
