Highway 23-88 leading from the Watkins Bridge koad to the Duncan Chapel Road in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Tract 6, on plat made by J. F. Bowers, C.S., August 31, 1936, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "I", at page 63, and having, according to a survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, December 7, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northeast edge of S. C. Highway 23-98, in line of property now or formerly of W. C. Hawkins, and property now or formerly of Nannie Miller Moody, and running thence along the Moody line, N 32-05 W 1801.38 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of property of M. Alice Childers, N 37-31 E 178.86 feet to a point on the Southwest edge of S. C. Highway 23-88; thence still with the Childers line crossing S. C. Highway 23-88, S 66-19 E 1423.50 feet to an iron pin; thence S 22-09 W 731.89 feet to an iron pin; thence S 25-17 W 160.97 feet to an iron pin at corner of property now or formerly of W. C. Hawkins; thence with the Hawkins line, S 22-01 W 293.98 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 21.62 acres, more or less.
