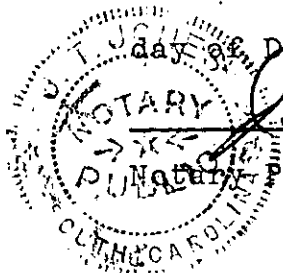
AFFIDAVIT

PERSONALLY appeared before me Troy E. Burdine, who on oath, says: That deponent is a resident of the State of Pennsylvania but was born and raised in Greenville County, South Carolina; that on or about February 9, 1924 deponent signed a deed together with J. T. Burdine, Lynda Howard, C. H. Burdine and Evie Wynn conveying about ten acres of land a part of the A. M. Burdine land near Saluda River in said County and State to M. M.
