Know All Men by These Presents:



That R. K. Taylor and R. K. Taylor, Jr. in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of TEN & NO/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS and other valuable consideration, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JAMES B. HENDERSON:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the Western side of Meridian Avenue in a Subdivision known as Super Highway Home Sites, being known and designated as Lot No. 123 of said Subdivision and being described according to a plat of Super Highway Home Sites recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P" at Page 53 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Meridian Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 123 and 124 and running thence along the common line of said Lots N. 71-06 W. 191.1 feet to an iron pin in the center of a 5-foot strip reserved for utilities, said iron pin being at the joint corner of Lots 123, 124, 117, 119 and 120; thence along the common line of Lots 120, 121 and 123, along the center of said 5-foot strip N. 48-28 E. 136 feet to an iron pin, the joint corner of Lots 121, 122 and 123; thence along the common line of Lots 122 and 123 along the center of said 5-foot strip S. 61-10 E. 110 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Meridian Avenue; thence along the Western side of Meridian Avenue S. 9-40 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The above described property is conveyed subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Super Highway Home Sites which are recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 291 at Page 369.

This property is also conveyed subject to such easements and rights-of-way as may appear of record.
