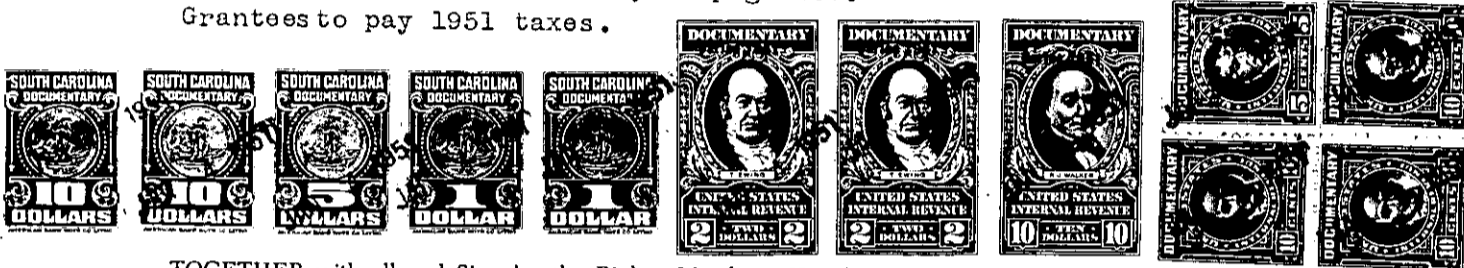
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jule C. Ingle and Calista I. Shelton, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of West Augusta Drive (also known as Augusta Drive, West) in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as a portion of Lots 11 and 12, on plat of Augusta Circle, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, November 1921, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "F", at page 23, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of West Augusta Drive, in the front line of Lot 11, said pin being 162.5 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the point where the Northeast side of West Augusta Drive intersects with the Southeast side of West Faris Road, and running thence through Lot 11, N 20-16 E 160 feet to an iron pin; thence S 55-15 E 62.5 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot 12; thence through Lot 12, S 20-16 W 160 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of West Augusta Drive; thence along said drive, N 55-15 W 62.5 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor by deed of John T. Davenport, dated May 31, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 222, at page 207.
