to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by William A. Henson
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William A. Henson

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, Beginning at an iron pin on the State Line,
the Northwest corner of a certain tract deeded by Leroy Moore,
Master, to Gus Henson dated July 27, 1933 and recorded in Book 169
ate page 125, records of Greenville County, South Carolina, and
running South 8 1/2 East 646 feet to an iron pin near a large white
oak; thence North 73 East 161 feet to an iron pin; thence North 3 1/2
East 576 feet to an iron pin at West margin of Highway No. 176;
thence with said margin of Highway North 56 West 49 feet to an
iron pin on State Line; thence with the State line North 86 1/2 West
240 feet to the beginning, containing 3 acres, more or less.
