

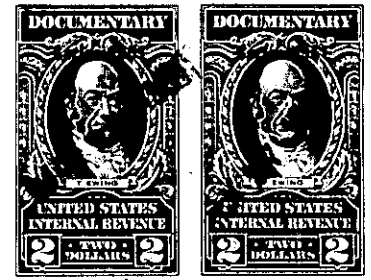

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Easterly side of Welcome Street, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 24 on the plat of Talmer Cordell Subdivision as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in plat Book "X", page 179, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING AT an iron pin on the Easterly side of Welcome Street at a point 118 feet south of the southeast corner of the intersection of Welcome Street and Welcome Road, joint front corner of lots 24 and 25 and running thence along the joint line of said lots N 76-0 E 160 feet to an iron pin; thence S 14-0 E 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 23 and 24; thence along the joint line of said lots S 76-0 W 160 feet to an iron pin on the Easterly side of Welcome Street; thence along the Easterly side of Welcome Street N 14-0 W 60 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is conveyed subject to a mortgage given by the Grantor to More, Inc. on October 5, 1950 in the amount of \$5,000.00 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Vol. 481, page 159.

The grantor covenants and agrees that this property is equipped with adequate water supply lines and that until such time as city water becomes available for use thereon, the grantor will furnish an adequate supply of water for residential purposes for the house now located on said property at the flat rate of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per month.
