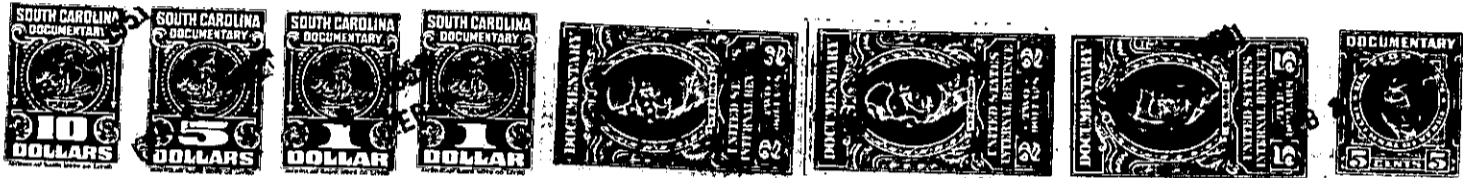

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of South Estate Drive, in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S.C., being shown as Lot 30, on plat of Crestwood, Inc., made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, February 28, 1949, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "S", at page 189, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of South Estate Drive, at joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30, and running thence with the line of Lot 29, S 65-05 W 134.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N 5-45 W 110 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 31, N 80-05 E 112 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of South Estate Drive; thence along the Southwest side of South Estate Drive, S 14-25 E 40 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Southwest side of South Estate Drive, S 22-00 E 40 feet to the beginning corner.
