

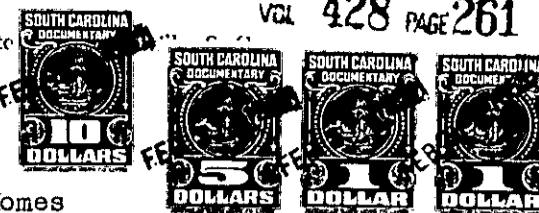

Gosnell, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 53, Block D, of a Sub-division known as Paris Heights, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book Z, page 39, revised and recorded in Plat Book Y, page 65, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING: At an iron pin on the Northerly side of Pisgah Drive, joint front corner Lots Nos. 53 and 54, Block D, and running thence N. 17-30 W. 125 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lots Nos. 52 and 53; thence S. 72-30 W. 130 feet to an iron pin on the Easterly side of Terrell Lane; thence along the Easterly side of Terrell Lane S. 17-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin in the Northeastern intersection of Terrell Lane; thence along the chord of the intersection of Terrell Lane and Pisgah Drive S. 62-30 E. 35.4 feet to an iron pin on the Northerly side of Pisgah Drive; thence along the Northerly side of Pisgah Drive N. 72-30 E. 105 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
