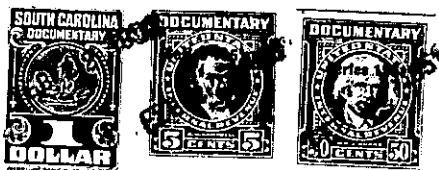

P. Asay, Jr., and T. G. Crymes, Jr., their heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel

or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northern side of Pacific Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 322, Pleasant Valley, according to plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P, page 114, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Pacific Avenue, which iron pin is 117.3 feet in a Westerly direction from an iron pin in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Pacific Avenue with Phoenix Avenue, thence along the Northern side of Pacific Avenue S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner Lots Nos. 322 and 323; thence N. 0-08 W. 147 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 318, 319, 322, and 323; thence N. 89-52 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 321 and 322; thence S. 0-08 E. 147 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
