I have an interest, located in the block bounded by the New Buncombe road and the Tindal Road the same being along the southern line of lot 78 and over the rear of lots 79-cross Gallahan Avenue to rear of lot 71; 72 to 76 inclusive; 96 to 103 inclusive; 116, 117, 119 to 135 inclusive; 136 to 156 inclusive; and along the Tindal road on lots 156, 157 and 158 Sans Souci Heights near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina; said sum is received in full payment of said rights.

The Company agrees to re-locate at its own expense, on said property, its lines and fixtures to conform with future building improvements.
