

outs at points in said line approximately 75 feet distant each from the other.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED, as a further consideration for this right-of-way, that the grantee will use cast-iron pipe in the construction of said line which is to be laid in accordance with the ordinances of the City of Greenville, S. C., and inspected by its plumbing inspector and health inspector, and is to be laid at least two feet net under the ground; all shrubbery, flowers or other yard beautification that is necessary to be moved when installing said line, or repairing same, shall be replaced at the expense of the grantee; the grantee and his Heirs and Assigns, as a further consideration for this right-of-way, agree to hold the grantor harmless at all times from every liability of whatsoever nature and kind either to persons or property in connection with the installation, inspection or maintenance of said line.
