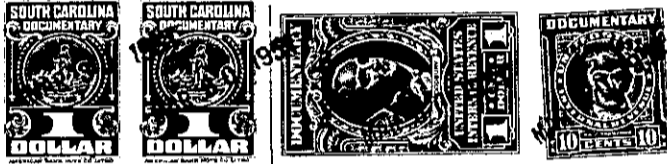

Dillard, her Heirs and Assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, lying on the North side of the new Super Highway No. 29, about three miles west of the City of Greer, and also lying on the west side of Dill Avenue, being a part of the property shown on plat made for Marshall Bright et al., by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated May 11, 1948, and being all of Lots 24 and 25 shown on said plat, having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
