That I, Louise Vaughn Compton, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) DOLLARS,

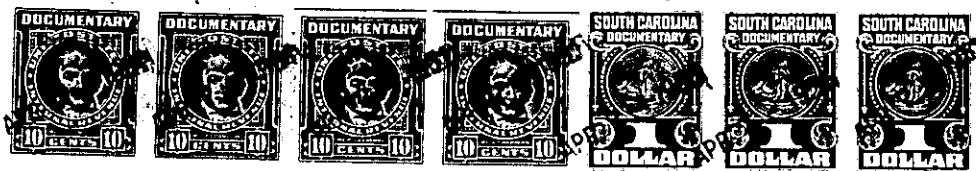

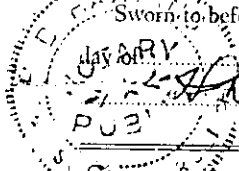
