WHEREAS, W. L. STAMEY AND B. H. CAPPS, JR.
both of Travelers Rest, S. C.

did on the 12th. day of April, 1951, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is THE THOROUGH BRED CLUB, I.C.
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is TRAVELERS REST, S. C.
- FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is
for the purpose of breeding thorough bred animals, including swine, cattle, and fowls; and to promulgate and enforce practices tending to encourage better handling of cattle, swine, and fowls; and other activities pertaining thereto.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable as the Directors may decide.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Thousand (1,000) of the par value of Five (\$.50) - - - - - Dollars.

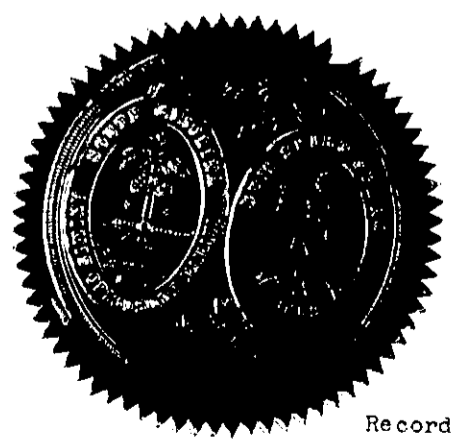
SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 9th. day of April, 1951, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:
W. L. Stamey, Millard Garland, B. H. Capps, Jr. and Thomas Reid

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, W. L. Stamey ;
as Vice-President, Millard Garland ; as Secretary, Millard Garland ;
as Treasurer, B. H. Capps, Jr.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Observer a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
