to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. E. Cox, his heirs and assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the East side of Whitney Street, in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 of Block A, as shown on a plat of the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book K, at pages 63, 64 and 65, and having, according to said plat, the following wtes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the East side of Whitney Street (formerly Hoover Street), joint front corner of Lots No. 2 and 3 of Block A, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 3, N. 41-48 E. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-46 E. 85 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 1 and 2; thence with the line of Lot No. 1, S. 50-57 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Whitney Street; thence with Whitney Street, N. 41-07 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to me by Enoch C. Ramsey and Ionie S. Ramsey, by deed dated January 14, 1944, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 260 at page 85.
