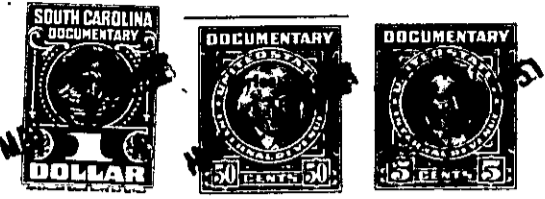

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the Southeast
side of Cumberland Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot
14 of Block "I" of Plat of Fair Heights made by R. E. Dalton,
Engineer, October, 1924, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book F, page 257, and

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of
