Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, D. F. Hughey, - - - - - in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-five (\$375.00) - - - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harper D. Hawkins and C. A. Bruce, their heirs and assigns, forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the south west side of U. S. Highway No. 25 (Greenville-Hendersonville Road) about 1 1/2 miles south of the North Carolina-South Carolina boundary line, and being a part of the property commonly known as "Chestnut Springs" the same being shown and designated on a plat of the property of D. F. Hughey, plat made by H. L. Dunahoo, surveyor, and dated April 25-27, 1951, said plat to be recorded in the R. E. C. office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances according to said plat, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of said U. S. Hwy. 25, joint corner of lots 7 and 8, and running thence S 63-30 W 467 feet to a point; thence S 58-30 W 1,990 feet to a point; thence S 49-00 E 561 feet to a point; thence S 79-00 E 969 feet to a stone; thence N 32-00 E 429 feet to an iron pipe; thence N 44-15 W 640 feet to an iron pipe at a Walnut on the north side of a branch; thence down said branch with the branch as the line 990 feet to a poplar stump on the south side of the branch; thence N 63-30 E 452 feet to a point on the western edge of U. S. Hwy. 25, said point being 12 feet north east of a chestnut stump; thence along the western edge of said U. S. Hwy. 25 320 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 33.2 acres, more or less.

This is a part of the property conveyed to D. F. Hughey by deed of the Master for Greenville County dated May , 1951, and recorded in the R. E. C. office for Greenville County.

(NOTE: All roads on said plat are void by agreement of the purchasers.)

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
